

On-going Notification for Pool/Spa Users (Non-lifeguarded Facilities)

All tenants, homeowners, club members, and guests must receive ongoing notification of the pool/spa rules as per WAC 246-260-131(9)(c). The information **must** include the following:

- 1. When the pool is used by children twelve years of age or under, a responsible adult eighteen years or older shall accompany the children and be at the pool or pool deck at all times the children use the facility.**
- 2. When used by persons thirteen to seventeen years of age, a minimum of two people, thirteen years of age or older, must be at the pool facility at all times the pool is in use.**

Other information such as pool and spa hours, safety rules, showering requirements, and location of phone and other emergency equipment may also be included.

Annual notification can be accomplished one or more of the following ways:

Hotel Guests:

- ◆ In the room guest directory
- ◆ Posted on the room door with the fire safety information
- ◆ Posted at the front desk
- ◆ On the televised hotel information channel



Health Clubs:

- ◆ Posted at the front desk
- ◆ Posted in locker rooms
- ◆ Newsletters
- ◆ New client information packets

Tenants/Homeowners:

- ◆ Newsletters
- ◆ Posted on bulletin boards in common areas
- ◆ New tenant information packets
